




#### **TOTAL # PARTICIPANTS**



# Amended & Restated Articles of Incorporation & Bylaws

- Changes made for several reasons
  - Members did not have voting rights
  - Bylaws needed provisions for voting procedures
  - Bylaws needed major update to reflect current youth soccer environment
- Articles were filed by NC Secretary of State on 5/27/20
- Bylaws were adopted by BOD on 7/21/20



### **Amended and Restated Bylaws**

- Three (3) Classes of Directors
  - For first election, to get terms staggered:
    - Class A 3 year term
    - Class B 2 year term
    - Class C 1 year term
  - For future elections:
    - Each class will serve 3 year terms
    - Only one class comes up for election each yr.
