

EVALUATION / TRYOUT FAQs

June 2016

Most all Juggernaut members will receive an invitation to return to the club with *specific* team assignments. Invitations for Gold/Cardinal/Silver players will go out after the banquet on Jun 5th. Invitations for Black/White players will go out after AAU Jr Nat'ls. Invites will direct each player/responsible family to register on-line for an appointment to come to the rMac to sign documents for the 2016-17 season. There are essentially *four* options for each invited player:

(1) If player accepts the team placement in the invite, she should come to the rMac with her parents to learn of her coach, her teammates, sign her paperwork, and get photographed. This process guarantees her a position on a specific team, but needs to be done no later than July 8, 2016. The player can join the rMac-4-Life program during this time, with a 5% dues discount, a 12 or 24 month payment schedule beginning in Jul 2016, no tryout fees, a free summer camp (with the purchase of another), and no tryout deposit (\$750 for Nat'l or Regional or \$500 Local).

(2) If player accepts the team placement in the invite (but would like the option to tryout for a higher team), she should come to the rMac with her parents to learn of her coach, her teammates, sign her paperwork, and get photographed. This process guarantees her a position on the initial team, but needs to be done no later than July 8, 2016. She should then attend an evaluation session or a scheduled tryout to try out for a higher team. Her initial team invite is secured for next season if she does not make the higher team. The player can join the rMac-4-Life program during this time, with a 5% dues discount, a 12 or 24 month payment schedule beginning in Jul 2016, no tryout fees, a free summer camp (with the purchase of another), and no tryout deposit (\$750 for Nat'l or Regional or \$500 Local).

(3) If a player does not choose to accept her team placement (or does not respond) by July 8, 2016, she would not have a guaranteed position for next season, would not be eligible for the rMac-4-Life promotion, and would need to schedule an evaluation or come to a try-out to be considered for a spot next season.

(4) If a player decides Juggernaut is not for her, please e-mail info@rmac.biz so we can remove her from any prospective roster and remove her from all mailing lists.

Jul-Aug 2016

All spots not filled by July 8, 2016 (through the above process) are open to any new or current Juggernaut player at any tryout session. Open tryouts will be held on July 9, July 15, July 31, and Aug 1. **Please note we may fill teams at the earlier tryouts, leaving fewer (if any) spots available at the later tryouts.** All players trying out will need to pay a \$35 tryout fee (if pre-registered on-line) or \$50 walk-up (unless they are already signed under the rMac-4-Life program).

Evaluation appointments may be scheduled via jess@juggernautvolleyball.com (potential national players) or tarah@juggernautvolleyball.com (potential regional players) or shelby@juggernautvolleyball.com (potential local players).

If we have any openings after the summer placements, we may hold OPEN tryouts in the fall of 2016. Please check www.juggernautvolleyball.com for times & dates.

What's up with the Jun-Aug dates? Our intent is to fill the roster spots for the majority of our teams throughout the summer. Fall tryouts will ONLY be for any remaining openings. This allows players to concentrate on the HS & GC season and not worry about which teams they will be on in the fall.

What are the PRE-Tryout Open Houses all about? For anyone who has not yet earned a spot in our program, we want you to get answers to questions and find out about Juggernaut BEFORE you commit your valuable time to our tryout selection process. If you like what we have to say, come to our tryouts and give it your best. Our PRE-Tryout meetings are designed to present you with an overview of what you can expect this season. Open Houses are held concurrently with any tryout session or by appointment. Tours and Q&A sessions are available.

How many teams will you have in each age group? We typically fill four to six teams per age group.

When will I know which team I am on?

In June if you are a returning player, or after your tryout if you are a new player (or a returning player looking for a higher team).

Who is my coach?

You may actually have as many as three to four coaches. You will have a Team Coach who will work specifically with your team during practice sessions, as well as at all tournaments. You may also have an assistant coach. All teams will have specific training coaches for each position's particular skills (i.e. setting, hitting, defense...). You will typically know your team coach before you sign up for the season.

Do you cut players?

Yes. In some circumstances we do. We are limited by the # of players we can accept based upon court and coach availability.

If I make a team when is my first payment due?

1st payments are due upon signing. Dues can be financed over six to seven months, (interest free) with payments due the 1st of each month beginning in November. If you are a part of our rMac-4-Life program, see page 9 for different payment details.

EVALUATION / TRYOUT STEPS

1. USAV MEMBERSHIP: EVERY participant MUST have a current USAV Junior Membership. Memberships may be purchased at: <http://rmrvolleyball.org/membership/indexMembership.html>. Your membership # should start with the letters "RM" and end with the # "16" or "17." Any other number will not authorize you to tryout. A "17" will be required to compete in the 2016-17 season.

2. JUGGERNAUT PRE-REGISTRATION: Go to www.mindbodyonline.com. In the upper right corner click on the "Log in" button. Search for "Juggernaut Volleyball" and select it. If you already have an account, just login. If not, click "Continue to site without logging in." On the right, under "New to our site" type in your name and click "Next." Follow the instructions to create an account. Please make sure the box next to "Subscribe to email reminders & notifications" is checked. If this box is not checked, then Juggernaut will not be notified of a booked appointment or class. Please also be sure to add each player in your family. This will allow you to sign-up for a selected service under your PLAYER's name (select appropriate relationship between each family member, including the payment options, e.g. 'pays for ...').

Once you are logged in, you'll see a menu of various tabs:
CLASSES / ENROLLMENTS / APPOINTMENTS / MY INFO / ONLINE STORE

Choose ENROLLMENTS to register for Tryouts. Proceed with choosing the service, date and time. Follow the checkout process, enter your credit card information and hit "Place order." After you have placed your order, you will receive a confirmation email/receipt.

To Register for: TRYOUTS

Go to ENROLLMENTS tab
Choose a Tryout date (that fits your age group). Click "Enroll." Proceed with checkout procedure.

3. DAY OF YOUR EVALUATION: Have your parents come with you and bring:

- Two checks (or credit card) payable to Juggernaut Volleyball: (1) \$50 non-refundable check for the tryout fee (no tryout fee check is required if you pre-registered and paid on-line at www.juggernautvolleyball.com or if you are a current rMac-4-Life member); (2) one check for the \$750 deposit (Nat'l or Regional) or \$500 deposit (Local) if you are offered a spot and you choose to join (no deposit required for rMac-4-Life members). This deposit is applied toward your dues.

- 2016-17 Juggernaut Volleyball Participation Agreement and Addendum (available at rMac)
- Two copies of player's Birth Certificate
