

Dear players and parents -

Thank you for signing up for the 2021 league at Wheaton Pavilion as a reminder the dates are Jan 23rd - Feb 27th and game times will be either 6:30, 7:30, 8:30 or 9:30. The schedule will be sent tomorrow and will be posted on the website for future reference. House team players I will be sending you a separate email letting you know the name of your team.

A few things to note :

House teams still need players so if you know people who might want to play please ask them to sign up ASAP. I have to submit rosters to the facility 24 hours before so I will be closing registration soon.

If there are goalies who want to play in more than one game please let me know because we are always in need of that.

For players that signed up as individuals I will have a pinnie for each player at the start of the league. These will be handed out before each game on the first day. Teams who signed up together should have their own.

Here are the basics from Wheaton

There is no additional congregating- once the horns blows from the timeclock your team(s) must immediately exit the field. Failure to do this will prevent the Pavilion staff from being able to properly sanitize the surface before the next renter(s).

To comply with current, updated government protocols, the following requirements are now in place for your safety and the safety of our staff:

- Until further notice – Capacity on the Field will be 25 including coaches and players. We are asking for no spectators, including parents, at this time.

So this means no more than 11 players are allowed to be in the facility at a time. Teams with larger teams we will come up with a system how to work this out. I will contact you directly.

- The Party Room at Wheaton Sports Pavilion is off limits and can not be rented.
- All Players must sign in at the Front Desk upon arrival. (THIS MUST BE DONE EACH WEEK)
 - **All players must also have or complete the attached waiver in order to be permitted into the facility. These will be available at the front desk; however, filling them out in advance and turning them in when you arrive is highly preferred.**

- Players will only be ***allowed to enter the facility 5-10 minutes prior to the start of their session***
- Players must come into the facility fully dressed (this includes their cleats). Goalkeepers will be provided an area inside to get dressed but must call the facility to get approval prior to arriving.
 - No bags are allowed inside the facility.
- **All players and coaches are required to wear a mask/face covering while in the facility, this includes while on the field.**
- Players and coaches should always be physically distant (6 feet)
- Player benches will be closed until further notice
- Locker rooms will be closed until further notice
- Water bottles must be labeled and may be left on top of the boards at the player benches. Water fountains are disabled, and customers may use one of the water bottle filling stations in the facility lobby area as needed.
- Players will need to leave the facility immediately after exiting the field; they will not be permitted to congregate in the lobby area
- The facility is not responsible for lost or stolen items and we will not be continuously overseeing a lost and found. Please only bring essentials for your practice into the facility, as needed. **NO BAGS.**
