

Hey all,

Thank you so much for your interest in our 2021 Summer Wolfie Kids Day Camp at NC State University! We are so excited to get back onto the field with each and every one of you. It's been tough to be away, and we can't wait to get started with you all on June 14th!

While we are excited to finally get permission from NC State to hold summer camps, there will be some **(university-required)** changes to previous years in order to make sure that everyone stays safe and healthy. For starters, each camper is required to turn in proof of a negative PCR tests on Monday morning (from a test taken within the previous 72 hours).

As you know, our camp is usually 4 days long – Monday through Thursday – with Thursday being a half day (9am-12pm). We just received notice from the university letting us know that any camps that are 4 days or longer will also require a SECOND proof of negative PCR test on the fourth morning (Thursday).

This means we would be requiring each of you to -

- Bring your camper to get a PCR test on Saturday/Sunday
- Turn proof of that negative test into us Monday morning at check-in
- Bring your camper to get a SECOND PCR test on Tuesday/Wednesday evening after camp ends
- Turn proof of that negative test into us Thursday morning prior to checking in for the last 3 hours of camp.

In order to eliminate the need for that second PCR test in the middle of the work week, we have decided to eliminate Thursday morning's 3-hour session and instead end the camp on Wednesday at 3pm.

NOW – we do know that that means we would be shorting each of you on 3 hours of soccer that you paid for.... And we want to make that up to you!

We've come up with a way to make up for that \$50 difference from losing 3 hours:

1. We will provide your camper with a top-of-the-line Adidas NC State Soccer jersey (on top of the usual camp t-shirt)
2. Anyone who signs up for camp will receive a promo code for \$50 credit towards next summer's Wolfie Day Camp.
