MISSING CHILD PROCEDURE

CHARLOTTE INDEPENDENCE SOCCER CLUB MISSING CHILD PROCEDURE

If you have a missing child at a CISC facility, report to a Club Representative IMMEDIATELY!!

Please provide a detailed description of the missing child: name, gender, age, clothing, height, weight, and last location and time the child was seen along with a picture if readily available.

Upon initial notice of a missing child, to the extent possible the complex will go on total shutdown and the following procedures will be initiated:

1. The highest ranking member of CISC Staff on site (CEO/Director/Coach the “In Charge”) will alert all CISC representatives and staff as well as parents and spectators that a child has been reported missing and the In-Charge will call 911.
2. To the extent possible under the circumstances, service road(s) to the soccer complex/fields will immediately be closed via a CISC representative vehicle moved to block the entrance – no one will be able to enter or exit the complex until the “all clear” signal is sounded.
3. The “In-Charge” will notify all referees and coaches and will initiate a search of the entire complex, including restrooms, concession stands, storage buildings and areas, parking lots, tree line areas, paths/greenways accessible from the soccer complex.
4. As and if necessary, games and practices may be suspended until the child is found.
5. The “In-Charge” will signal “All Clear” when child is found.
