#### DAY 1 – June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Departure from USA

#### Day 2 – June 19<sup>th</sup> 2020 Barcelona arrival / Free time

Arrival to Barcelona international airport and meeting with your bilingual tour manager and your private motor-coach.

Transfer then to Barcelona downtown.

Free time to give a first look to the colorful city on your own.



**Barcelona** is the capital and the most populous city of the Autonomous Community of Catalonia and the second largest city in Spain, after Madrid. Barcelona is recognised as a Global City due to its importance in finance, commerce, media, entertainment, arts, international trade, education and tourism. Indeed, it is a major economic centre and a growing financial centre. Barcelona occupies 13th place in the world on Innovation Cities globally. It is the 4th richest city by GDP in the European Union. Enjoy botanical and urban parks, sandy beaches, the metropolitan area, art Museums as those of Picasso and Mirò together with the Maritime, the Archeology and Science one.

Final transfer to your hotel, dinner included and overnight.

#### Day 3 – June 20<sup>th</sup> 2020 Camp Nou Stadium in Barcelona / Mini tournament with local teams

After breakfast, in the morning transfer to visit the glorious Camp Nou, home to FC Barcelona.

**Camp Nou** - built between 1954 and 1957, officially opened on the 24th of September 1957. Camp Nou initially consisted of two tiers that could hold 93,000 spectators. It was first called Estadi del FC Barcelona, but got soon referred to as Camp Nou. He then expanded with a third tier for the 1982 World Cup, which raised capacity to 120,000 places. Now the capacity is around 100,000 seats, due to some other changes. In the mid 2000s, the club presented plans for a renovated Camp Nou, designed by Norman Foster, but a lack of funding prevented realization. These some of the most important games of past: In 1989, Camp Nou hosted the European Cup final between AC Milan and FC Steaua (4-0), in 1999 by the Champions League final between Manchester United and FC Bayern (2-1).

Lunch on own.

Enjoy your last afternoon at leisure in the city. You may go to visit the famous Montjuic, from where you will have a wonderful panorama, have fun at Tibidabo amusement park or just relax on the giant beaches in Barceloneta.



Or

take the chance to visit Sagrada Familia, one of the most famous churches in the world (entry ticket not included).



The **Sagrada Familia** is one of the most famous landmarks in Barcelona. The church is such a huge size, so they often referred it as "cathedral", but without having a bishop's seat. Pope Benedict XVI. inaugurates the Sagrada Familia on November 7, 2010. The church building is raised to a basilica. The church in the district Eixample is being built since 1882, and is supposed to be finished in 2026. From 1883 the Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí took over the leadership of the works until his death in 1926. The building is significantly influenced by him.

In the afternoon transfer to a local sport centre to play a mini tournament with local teams.
