



The Mountain Top league (MTL) is an all-volunteer organization which serves the children of West Orange, NJ. MTL provides recreational and travel programs for Baseball, Basketball, Soccer, Softball and Ice Hockey. Each sport is run by a group of volunteers "Trustees".

The responsibilities of a Trustee vary based on the sport, but at a high level the group of Trustees are responsible for the following:

Day to day management of their sport which includes:

- Collaboration with other Trustees to determine program
- Determine seasonal, daily schedule and time frame for program
- Collaboration with Recreation Department and other sport Trustees for field/gym space
- Creation and monitoring of registration portal
- Management of sport specific email box
- Along with the other Trustees, become a central point of contact for parents of participants, volunteer coaches, trainers, Recreation Department and MTL Executive Board
- Set program pricing and communication cadence
- Handle all sport related issues (Parent concerns, child safety, treatment of field, treatment of town/sport officials, participant issues)
- Attendance of a monthly MTL meeting which individual sport related topics are discussed

Becoming a Trustee:

- A person can express interest in becoming a Trustee with the current sport Trustees through the sport specific email (Contact Us Page)
- The sport Trustees will then nominate a person to become a Trustee
- The MTL Trustees and Executive Board will vote on the Inclusion of the nominated person
