- 3. **Financial Oversight:** Assist in financial oversight to ensure the association's financial health and sustainability. Engage in fundraising efforts and donor cultivation.
- 4. **Community Engagement:** Build and maintain relationships with key stakeholders, including members, athletes, coaches, volunteers, sponsors, and community partners. Represent the association at relevant events and functions.
- 5. **Program Development:** Contribute to the development and enhancement of athletic programs, events, and initiatives. Champion inclusivity, diversity, and equity within the association's programs and policies.
- 6. **Advocacy and Outreach:** Advocate for the interests of the association within the broader athletic community and with relevant authorities. Serve as a spokesperson for PSAA as needed.

Oversee a consistent program for Coaches Code of Conduct, Players Code of Conduct, Background Checks and Waivers. Work with Sports Commissioners on any sport specific insurance.
