- No coach meeting. Official rosters can be turned in at the tournament director's table.
- R1 will be provided for all rounds.
- Ref team = four players (eight total) at each score table to complete the paper score sheet, scoreboard and two line judges in both gyms. (Not providing R2, libero checker.) Coaches and players are encouraged to make honor calls to help the R1.
- All rounds 2 games to 25 points. No cap.

### **Awards**

Medals for first and second place based on win/loss record, head-to-head and point differential.

Queen of the Court medals: Coaches and referees will get a slip to nominate the best players or those who show superior sportsmanship. Tournament Director will collect forms before final round.

### **Spectators:**

Admission through cash donation to Elcho Volleyball Team or a non-perishable food item for the Elcho Food Pantry.

Each team is allowed **2 Spectator per player**

Concessions provided by the Elcho High School volleyball team and their coaches. **Please do not bring in your own food and beverages** - water bottles only. Food and drink should stay in the commons.

Court #1 has a Pixellot camera. Games in that gym will be streamed via [nfhsnetwork.com](http://nfhsnetwork.com). An NFHS subscription is required to view their events. Sorry, court #2 does not have a camera.

### **Safety Precautions & Social Distancing:**

- ★ No coin toss. Team that traveled the farthest gets to serve first in the first set of each match, then alternating for successive sets.
- ★ Field house - teams stay on the same side of the net for the entire match. Classic gym teams may choose to switch sides because of overhead obstruction (batting cage).
- ★ Everyone utilizes face coverings/masks at all times.
- ★ Multiple touchless water bottle filling stations located in the commons.
- ★ Locker rooms will not be available.
- ★ Ice will be available, if needed. No athletic trainer on site.
- ★ Each team will have a designated area in each of the following locations for the entire event:
  - Commons (cafeteria tables)
  - Hallway for gym bags
  - All Coaches/Players/Spectators **MUST** stay in their designated area, in the commons, when they are not playing.
